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



A WORD FROM THE WINEMAKER

A historically recognized terroir in Northern Burgundy, having grown to 1000 hectares, the vineyards of Vermenton are slowly being reborn following the phylloxera epidemic that caused them to be forgotten. Its hillsides, classified as AOC Burgundy in 1992, have undergone a veritable renaissance thanks to several winegrowers and winemakers, in particular my parents Cécile and Mathieu Yverneau. In November 2023, I was able to make two of my dreams come true: to take over the family vineyard and to promote the Vignoble de Vermenton through distinctive, lively wines.
